

SiSiB® PC19591 Silicone Emulsifier

How to use:

Slowly add the water phase into the oil phase, and then stir the mixture quickly till uniform.

Speeding up the stirring can improve the stability of the emulsion system.

Stir the oil and emulsifier thoroughly before adding water to emulsify.

If all the ingredients are liquid, emulsification can be operated at room temperature without homogenizer. Quick stirring can attain stable emulsion.

Adding some antifreeze agents such as propanediol and glycerin can improve the antifreeze effect of the finished product.

Increasing the water proportion can improve viscosity of the system.

RECOMMENDED DOSAGE

The recommended usage level of this product is 1%-5% when it's used as major emulsifier, and 0.1%-1.5% as auxiliary emulsifier (according to the total amount of the formulation).
